WHEREAS the Town of St. Croix Falls adopted their own Zoning Ordinance on August 5, 1965, amended in its entirely on May 12, 1994 and subsequent amendments including the amendments on March 20, 2001; January 16, 2008; February 18, 2009; May 20, 2009; October 21, 2009; March 17, 2010; April 21, 2010; August 18, 2010; March 16, 2011; April 20th 2011; October 19, 2011; November 16, 2011; August 21, 2013; March 18, 2015; and

WHEREAS Polk County has just completed a comprehensive revision of their zoning ordinance.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of St. Croix Falls, Polk County, Wisconsin, intends to continue exercising its powers to enforce the Town's existing Zoning Ordinance No. 1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of St. Croix Falls does not intend to adopt the county zoning ordinance.
